Applicant / accused Muhammad Paryal is present alongwith his Counsel and seeks protective bail in Direct Complaint No.01 of 2022 brought on record against applicant and others for offences under Sections 386, 387, 506/2, 147, 148, 149 PPC r/w Section 6/7 of Anti-Terrorism Act, 1997. It is *inter alia* contended that applicant/accused is prepared to surrender before the trial Court but apprehends his arrest as the NBWs have been issued against him. Serious mala fide on the part of complainant has been alleged.

Without touching the merits of the case, applicant/accused is granted protective bail for a period of 04(four) days, subject to his furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand) and P.R. Bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court. Applicant / accused is directed to surrender before the trial Court within the aforesaid period. Meanwhile, operation of NBWs issued against the applicant shall stand suspended.

This order shall cease to have its effect on expiry of 04(four) days from today i.e. upto 10.03.2022 or whenever the applicant / accused surrenders himself before the trial Court. It is made clear that in case the applicant / accused failed to surrender before the concerned Court within stipulated period, his bail bonds shall stand automatically forfeited.

Bail application stands disposed of in above terms.
