Applicants Himat Ali and Sikandar Ali are present alongwith their Counsel and seek protective bail in FIR No.08/2017 registered at Police Station Sobho Dero District Khairpur for the offences under Section 302, 337-H(ii), 148, 149, 109 and 7 of Anti-Terrorism Act, 1997. Counsel for applicants/accused submits that after usual investigation final report has been submitted, in which the applicants/accused have been shown as absconders. Counsel for the applicants/accused further submits that the names of the applicants/accused did not transpire in the FIR and they have no knowledge regarding the submission of challan against them. Serious *mala fide* on the part of Police has been alleged. It is also submitted that the applicants are prepared to surrender before the Trial Court but apprehend their arrest on the way to Anti-Terrorism Court, Khairpur.

Without touching the merits of the case, the applicants/accused are granted protective bail for a period of 05(five) days, subject to their furnishing solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/- (Rupees One Hundred Thousand) each and P.R. Bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court. Applicants/accused are directed to surrender themselves before the trial Court within the aforesaid period. This order shall cease to have its effect on expiry of five days from today or whenever the applicants/accused surrender themselves before the trial Court, whichever is earlier. Operation of the N.B.Ws issued against the applicants/accused shall stand suspended for the aforesaid period.

Bail application stands disposed of.
