Through the instant Constitutional Petition, petitioner Raheem Bux Khalti has prayed for the following reliefs:-

- to direct the respondent No.3 to bring the name of petitioner in the merit list as per his qualifications and thereafter issue offer letter to the petitioner and after completing the formalities he may be deemed to be a civil servant with all fringed rights and benefits.
- To declare that the PTC certificate issued to the Respondent No.5 b) is illegal and unlawful and cannot deemed to be in existence and is of no effect.
- To declare that the offer letter issued to the respondents No.4 and c) 5 are illegal and unlawful and of no legal effect.
- To restrain the defendant No.3 from taking steps to resumption of d) duties of the respondents upon fake certificate and mis-statements furnished and fake certificates.
- To take necessary legal action against the delinquent officers and e) beneficiaries of such fake certificates/verifications and entering name of the respondents in subsequent merit lists and they may be brought to book.
- To pass order for re-verification of all educational certificates of the f) respondents No.4 and 5.
- Notices were issued to the respondents as well as Addl. A. G. 2. Comments have been filed on behalf of respondents No.3 to 6.
- After hearing the learned Counsel for the parites, by consent, 3. petition is disposed of in the following terms.
 - Petitioner Raheem Bux will appear before the D.R.C, where matter is pending. D.R.C after hearing the petitioner and other concerned persons shall decide the issue involved in the petition within the period of two months in accordance with law, under intimation to this Court.
