Petitioner claims that respondent No.5 being her brother and I/O has a dispute in respect of immoveable property. The petitioner has filed this petition alleging that taking undue advantage of his position and status, respondent No.5 is coercing and threatening the petitioner. Respondent No.5, arrayed as being a private respondent, writ as such cannot be issued under Article 199 of the Constitution. In case petitioner is being threatened for dire consequences, as alleged in the petition, she may take steps by either lodging the FIR or on its refusal may file an application before the concerned District & Sessions Judge under section 22-A Cr.P.C. or a private complaint whatever course may be chosen by the petitioner but such indulgence and investigation cannot be done in these proceedings. The question regarding immovable property is also subjudice in Suit No.281 of 2016 before a Senior Civil Judge Central Karachi. Such being the case, hardly an indulgence is required in these proceedings as such the petition is dismissed along with listed application.
