This plea is also misconceived in view of the judgment of the Supreme Court passed in Gul Taiz Khan Marwat vs. The Registrar, Peshawar High Court, Peshawar (PLD 2021 SC 391). In view hereof no case is made out, hence, this petition is dismissed in limine alongwith pending applications.
