It is also correct that I took shalter in Dar-ul-Aman on account of fear from my husband. It is correct that I have recorded my statement on oath that I would like to record my evidence in favour of my sisters and brother-in-law, against whom my husband has recorded false F.I.R. Today I say that the earlier statement was recorded by me under coercion as my youngest son, namely, Muhammad Usman was in illegal custody of my two sisters and my brother-in-law. It is correct that I was sent to Dar-ul-Aman alongwith my youngest son Muhammad Usman, who was handed over to me by my sisters and brother-in-law outside the Court premises on the assurance that I have recorded the earlier dated 27.8.2014. It is correct that on 27.8.2014 my two sons, namely, Mohsin Ali and Ahsan Ali were in custody of my husband, who have been brought by my husband today in Court.

I have come from Dar-ul-Aman under police custody. Now I want to go to my husband, since the custody of my youngest son was handed over to me and I have no fear from my sisters and brother-in-law. I would depose against my sisters and my brother-in-law and two other persons, who had abducted me and detained me at Lahore in my mother's house. At the time of recording my earlier statement on oath, my two elder sons were in the custody of my husband and I had no fear because they were in the custody of their real father, whereas my youngest son was in custody of my sisters and brother-in-law, who could have done anything with my child.
