Perusal of the prayer clauses of the petitions demonstrate that a non-specific overarching relief has been sought with respect to the entire Scheme No.29, Musharaf Colony, Baldia Town, Karachi. 19 official respondents have been impleaded without it being discernible as to what relief is sought from the respective offices. The allegations are of a factual nature requiring inquiry/investigation/evidence and such adjudication is not warranted in writ jurisdiction. Since no specific stance of grievance has articulated before us, therefore, the *locus-standi* of the petitioners to maintain such a generic petition would also not be established. Learned counsel for the Respondent states that the Petitioners are encroachers and under the garb of these petitions are seeking to perpetuate their illegal activities.

Be that as it may, in view of the observations as aforesaid, the petitions appear to be misconceived, hence, dismissed along with listed applications. Office is directed to place a copy in lthe connected petition.
