Learned counsel for the petitioner may file amended title whereafter notice may be issued to the newly impleaded respondent for 23.04.2025. The newly impleaded respondent is directed to ensure that the responsible officer conversant with the facts is available in Court to assist on the next date."

Today, Mr.Khalid Rajpar, Advocate is present along with Mr.Tariq Aziz, Assistant Collector SAPT and Mr.Shakeel Ahmed, Second Secretary, Facilitation Mechanism. He has filed Vakalatnama on behalf of Respondent No.6, which is taken on record. He states that remaining two J.Ds also stand de-blocked. In view of such statement, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition, hence, the same is disposed of.
