- **1.** Urgency is granted.
- **2.** Deferred.
- **3.** Exemption is granted subject to all just legal exceptions.
- **4.** Through this bail application, applicant/accused Abdul Khalique S/o Jalauddin Mahar seeks protective bail in Crime No.66/2023, registered at Police Station Sangi, District Sukkur U/S 302, 324, 365-A, 148, 149, 109, 114, 120-B, 452, 427, 354, 337-H(2) PPC and 7 of Anti-Terrorism Act, 1997.

Learned Counsel, *inter alia*, contends that applicant's name is not mentioned in FIR, however, in interim Challan, he has been arraigned as accused and shown absconder. He intends to appear before the Court concerned, but apprehends his immediate arrest as non-bailable warrants have been issued against him. Hence, he seeks protective bail.

Without touching merits of the case, protective bail for a period of **eight (08) days** w.e.f. 15.01.2024 to 22.01.2024 (both days inclusive) is granted to applicant subject to his furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) and PR bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court. Operation of non-bailable warrants in this case, if any, shall remain suspended during aforesaid period, in

which applicant is directed to surrender before the Court concerned. This order shall cease to have its effect after expiry of above mentioned period or whenever applicant surrenders before the Court concerned, which one occurs earlier. It is, however, made clear that in case applicant fails to surrender before the Court concerned within stipulated period, his bail bond shall stand automatically forfeited.

The bail application stands **disposed of** in the above terms.
