**<u>4.</u>** Through this bail application, applicant/accused Abdul Qadeer S/o Muhammad Shareef seeks protective bail in Crime No.222 of 2023, registered at Police Station Kumb U/S 302, 324, 353 PPC and 7 of Anti-Terrorism Act, 1997.

Learned Counsel contends that applicant is innocent, has been falsely implicated in this case. He further contends that applicant is ready to appear before the Court concerned along with an application U/S 498 CrPC to prove his innocence. However, he apprehends his immediate arrest as non-bailable warrant has been issued against him. Hence, he seeks protective bail.

Without touching merits of the case, protective bail for a period of **seven (07) days** w.e.f. 19.02.2024 to 25.02.2024 (*both days inclusive*) is granted to applicant subject to his furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of Rs.50,000/- (*Rupees fifty thousand*) and PR bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court. Operation of non-bailable warrant in this case, if any, shall remain suspended during aforesaid period, in which applicant is directed to surrender before the Court concerned. This order shall cease to have its effect after expiry of above

mentioned period or whenever applicant surrenders before the Court concerned, which one occurs earlier. It is, however, made clear that in case applicant fails to surrender before the Court concerned within stipulated period, his bail bond shall stand automatically forfeited.

The bail application stands **disposed of** in the above terms.
