



Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in para No.20 of the comments filed by the NADRA, it has been stated that the petitioners have not availed the proper remedy before the competent authority i.e. Director General (NADRA) Regional Office before filing this petition. Learned counsel further states that as the petitioners want to avail that remedy first in accordance with law, ^{and therefore} he will not be pressing this petition. Simultaneously he requests that some time may be fixed for deciding such application, if it is filed by the petitioners before the competent authority.

To such proposal, learned counsel for NADRA has no objection.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed as withdrawn. If the petitioners avail the above mentioned remedy before the competent authority, it may be dealt with strictly in accordance with law and be decided within a period of 20 days.
