- 1.** Urgency is granted.
- 2.** Exemption is granted subject to all just legal exceptions.
- 3.** Through this bail application, applicants / accused Ghulam Murtaza alias Meer Murtaza and Ishfaq Ali, both sons of Ghulam Mustafa Gadani seek protective bail in Crime No.80 of 2024, registered at Police Station Khanpur Mahar, District Ghotki u/s 302, 147, 148, 149, 337-H(2) PPC.

Learned Counsel contends that applicants are innocent, have been falsely implicated in this case. He further contends that applicants are ready to appear before the Court concerned along with an application u/s 498 CrPC to prove their innocence. However, they apprehend their immediate arrest as non-bailable warrants have been issued against them. Hence, they seek protective bail.

Without touching merits of the case, protective bail for a period of **seven (07) days** w.e.f. 25.04.2024 to 01.05.2024 (*both days inclusive*) is granted to applicants subject to their furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of Rs.30,000/- (*Rupees thirty thousand*) each and PR bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of Additional Registrar of this Court. Operation of non-bailable warrants in this case, if any, shall remain suspended during aforesaid period, in which applicants are directed to surrender before the Court concerned. This order shall cease to have its effect after expiry of above mentioned period or whenever applicants surrender before the Court concerned, which one occurs earlier. It is, however, made clear that in case applicants fail to surrender before the Court concerned within stipulated period, their bail bonds shall stand automatically forfeited.

The bail application stands **disposed of** in the above terms.
