SSP Dadu has appeared and has filed a comprehensive statement stating that the claim of the applicant is that his son went missing in the year 2003 / 2004 but he filed application for registration of F.I.R. against some accused nominated therein before the learned Sessions Judge in the year 2015 but it was dismissed. Subsequently, applicant filed a petition for registration of the F.I.R. before this court which was allowed and an F.I.R. No.01/2018 was registered at P.S Johi against private respondents, which was disposed of by the Investigating Officer under "A" class. However, the report of the Investigating Officer was not accepted by the learned Magistrate concerned and he took cognizance of the offence against the accused and currently they are facing trial before the court of learned Civil Judge and Judicial Magistrate, Johi. The SSP has further stated that the petitioner is in habit of moving applications and has referred to various applications in this regard moved by the petitioneragainst police officials and against respondents.

Be that as it may, since the case of abduction of son of the applicant is pending in the court of law, as such, the applicant may approach the said court against the respondents.

Since the SSP Dadu in categorical terms has stated and has filed report in this regard that they have made efforts and have conducted proper investigation in which the allegation leveled by the petitioner were found baseless, this petition merits no consideration and is accordingly dismissed.
