By means of this miscellaneous application the applicant, who is present in person, is seeking setting aside of order dated 13.03.2017 passed on his Criminal Miscellaneous Application No.297/2017 under section 22-A & B Cr.P.C by learned 3rd Additional Sessions Judge/Ex-Officio Justice of Peace, Hyderabad. In his above application the applicant sought direction against the respondents not to cause harassment to him. The applicant claims to be the government employee in EOBI Department since 1996 in BPS-15 and respondent No.1 is the Director General (Operation), EOBI, whereas, respondent No.2 is the Deputy Director General, B & C-1 EOBI, B & C Department, against whom the applicant filed the above application.

In the impugned order learned Ex-Officio Justice of Peace has observed that the applicant has admitted that he has filed a C.P No.D-2308/2014 against the same respondents on the same cause of action before this Court and in view of such fact his application was dismissed. Applicant has been asked to point out any illegality in the same order, but he has failed.

In view of the pendency of a C.P No.D-2308/2014 filed by the applicant against the said respondents on the same cause of action, admittedly he could not maintain his application under section 22-A & B Cr.P.C before the Ex-Officio Justice of Peace. No illegality is found in the said order. Consequently, this main application is dismissed alongwith listed applications.
