Applicant present in person. Mr. Nazar Muhammad Memon, Addl.P.G.

I have heard the applicant in person, who wants to get an F.I.R. registered against the proposed accused for issuing him a fake cheque of Rs.4,00,000/- in the year 2015, which on presentation in the bank was dishonored. The applicant filed an application u/s 22A(6)(i) Cr.P.C before IIIrd Additional Sessions Judge, Shaheed Benazirabad for registering an F.I.R. against the proposed accused but did not succeed and his application was dismissed through the impugned order.

I have gone through the impugned order. Learned Ex-Officio Justice of Peace / Additional Sessions Judge, Shaheed Benazirabad has given cogent reasons for refusing to pass directions for registration of F.I.R. as pleaded by the applicant after perusing the entire record and keeping in consideration the enmity between the parties and particularly the report of the bank that the cheque was returned due to difference of signature thereon. I do not find any justification to interfere in these findings and dismiss this Criminal Miscellaneous Application. However, the applicant would still be at liberty to avail remedy including direct complaint against the proposed accused in accordance with law.
