Learned Counsel for the petitioner has filed a statement alongwith certain documents; taken on record.

At the very outset learned Counsel for the petitioner has admitted that the petitioner is a civil servant and was appointed as Junior Clerk ((BPS-07) in the Board of Revenue Sindh in the year 2012 and was posted initially in the office of Deputy Commissioner Naushehro Feroze whereafter he was transferred and posted in the office Deputy Commissioner, Jamshoro where he was paid salaries upto March 2015 and thereafter the same were stopped.

We have asked the learned Counsel as to how this petition is maintainable keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is a civil servant and the issue of salary comes within the terms and conditions of service. He has candidly conceded to it and does not press this petition by submitting that he would file an appeal before the Service Tribunal but submits the point of limitation may come against him.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed as not pressed alongwith listed application. However, if the petitioner files an appeal as above, the period of limitation may be considered sympathetically.
