<u>O R D E R</u>

<u>ADNAN-UL-KARIM MEMON.J</u>:- The petitioner seeks a court directive compelling respondent No. 1 to permit him to rejoin his employment.

- 2. Despite being appointed as a PST in 2014, fulfilling all requirements, and performing his duties, the petitioner has received no salary. He seeks a court order to compel payment and the opening of his official ID, as his repeated requests and official validations have been ignored.
- 3. The respondent states that the petitioner's appointment was challenged in a prior court case, resulting in a DRC review that recommended its cancellation. They submit that the petitioner has no valid claim after a significant time lapse and denies any record of a valid appointment order.
- 4. We have heard the parties present in court and perused the record with their assistance.
- 5. It is agitated that following the issuance of an appointment offer to the petitioner, one Abdul Rahim filed a petition (C.P No. D-1708/2011) in this Court, challenging the petitioner's PTC degree, which granted him additional marks. Subsequently, on 13-5-2014, this Court directed the District Recruitment Committee (DRC) to review the petitioner's case. The DRC found the petitioner's PTC certificate to be invalid and recommended the cancellation of his appointment. Instead, Abdul Rahim was selected for the PST position on 12-09-2014. If this is the position of the case this court is left with no option but to dispose of the petition in terms of order dated 13-5-2014 passed by this court in C.P No. D-1708/2011.
