ORDER

MUHAMMAD IQBAL KALHORO J: Applicants Nadir Ali, Muhammad Usman and Saeed Ahmed are seeking bail in Crime No.670/2024 U/s 395 PPC of P.S. Surjani Town, Karachi.

- 2. As per brief facts, complainant has alleged that he had bought some animals for sacrifice, which were tethered outside his house. On 08.06.2024 at least 12/14 sindhi speaking persons came duly armed with weapons, snatched his animals and took them away in a Mazda. Hence FIR.
- 3. Learned counsel for applicants submits that applicants are innocent and have been falsely implicated in the case; there is no evidence to connect the applicants with alleged offence; their names are not mentioned in the FIR; applicants were arrested in some other FIR of P.S. Sohrab Goth u/s 395, 397 PPC and were implicated in this case.
- 4. On the other hand, learned Addl. P.G. has opposed the bail stating that after arrest, identification parade of the applicants was held in which they have been rightly picked up by the complainant to be the same culprits.
- 5. I have considered submissions of the parties and perused material available on record. The applicants were identified by the complainant to be the same culprits in the identification parade, who had committed the alleged offence. In view of such piece of evidence identifying applicants to be involved in this case, no case for bail is made out.
- 6. In view of above circumstances, this bail application is dismissed. The trial court is however, directed to examine material witnesses within three months, after which the applicants would be at liberty to repeat their bail application which will be decided on its own merits.

The observations made herein above are tentative in nature and would not prejudice case of either party at trial.

The Cr. Bail Applications are disposed of.
