1. 1. Urgency granted. 3. Exemption granted subject to all just exceptions. 2, 4 & 5. This petition was heard on 21.04.2025, however, upon being confronted as to maintainability, time was sought to prepare. Today, once again, learned counsel remains unable to satisfy the court on account of maintainability.

Per learned counsel, no GD has been filed by the petitioner as of date since the consignment has not yet arrived, however, this petition has been preferred seeking to revive some exemption *admittedly* withdrawn / no longer holding the field.

Counsel demonstrated the existence of previous instruments, issued in 2006 and thereafter, wherein the present quantum of levy was different, however, remained unable to assist as to how the prevailing duties, taxes etc. could be disregarded simply because the quantum had been lesser earlier.

Prima facie the nature of instrument and manner of imposition was consistent in all the SROs demonstrated before us. Learned counsel remained unable to assist as to how an instrument raising the quantum of levy was considered discrepant, when identical instruments, reducing the quantum, were being relied upon.

In view hereof and coupled with the ratio illumined recently by the Supreme Court in *Mekotex*<sup>1</sup>, no case is made out to merit invocation of the discretionary<sup>2</sup> writ jurisdiction of this Court, therefore, this petition, along with pending application/s, is hereby dismissed *in limine*.
