Mr. Amjad Ali Almani, Advocate files Power on behalf of
Respondents No.9 and 12, namely Muhammad Murad and
Nazeer Ahmed, they are also present in person. Statements
have been filed by official respondents No.3, 5, 7 and 8, those
are also taken on record, copy whereof is provided to learned
counsel for the petitioners.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that the
petitioners have contracted marriage according to their own free
will and wish, the private respondents have become annoyed on
that and causing harassment for them. He further contended
that respondent No.9, Muhammad Murad being maternal-uncle
of Petitioner No.1 has filed an application u/s 491, CrPC for
recovery of Petitioner No.1, Mst. Mukhtiar, though she has
married with Petitioner No.2 namely, Muhammad Jiyal being *sui
juris*. Counsel for the petitioners after going through the
statements of official respondents seeks disposal of this petition.

Learned AAG on behalf of official respondents states that
the official respondents are duty bound to provide protection to
the petitioners in accordance with the law. He further submits
that neither the official respondents have caused harassment to
the petitioners nor they intend to do so in future. Counsel
appearing for Respondents No. 9 and 12 also submit that the
said respondents will not cause any sort of harassment for the
petitioners; however, he submits that any action if required they
will take in accordance with the law.

In view of the above, this petition is hereby disposed of with direction to the official respondents to provide protection to the petitioners, as and when required in accordance with the law. Private respondents are also directed to act in accordance with the law. Copy of this order be provided to learned Additional AG for compliance.
