"Accordingly, this petition is disposed of by directing the Appellate Tribunal Inland Revenue Karachi to decide the pending Appeal expeditiously preferably within 60 days from the date hereof. However, the respondents shall not take any coercive action against the petitioner, in respect of the impugned demand, till the conclusion of the Appeal."

It is made clear that learned counsel for the petitioner shall not cause any delay in the proceedings before the Appellant Tribunal. A copy of this order shall be sent to Appellate Tribunal Inland Revenue Karachi through fax and electronic mode for compliance.

The instant petition stands disposed of in the above terms along with listed applications.
