None present for the petitioner. Pursuant to process, the respondent No.3 has appeared along with his Counsel. Statements have been filed on behalf of SHO PS Dodapur as well as SSP, Jacobabad, taken on record. In their statements the police officials have categorically mentioned that respondent No.4 got registered FIR bearing Crime No.08/2025 with PS Dodapur, u/s 506/2, 148, 149, PPC against the sons of petitioner as well as her family. Said case has been challaned, which is now pending for trial before the Court of Civil Judge & JM, Garhi Khairo vide Cr. Case No. Nil / 2025 re-The State v. Muhammad Nawaz & others. Learned Counsel for respondents No.3 & 4 submits that the sons of petitioner are also shown absconders in said crime and are avoiding to appear before the trial Court, instead under the garb of this petition have been exerting pressure upon the private respondents as well as trial Court not to proceed with the case or issue any process against them. As far as allegation of harassment is concerned, learned Counsel submits that the respondents No.3 & 4 have not caused harassment to the petitioner or her family, rather the petitioner and her sons are exerting pressure upon them so that they may not come to their lands which are being disturbed by them. The learned AAG assisted by the police officer, is also of same view that the official respondents will not cause harassment to the petitioner and he will direct them to act strictly in accordance with the law by providing her protection, as and when she may approach to them.
