In response to notice the respondents No.1 to 5 file their statements, which are taken on record; copies whereof provided to counsel for the petitioner. The respondents No.1 to 5 have denied the allegations as contained in the petitioner. They have further stated that they have neither caused harassment to petitioner nor would harass him in future,

Perusal of statements filed by official respondents shows that the relatives of the petitioner are involved in some criminal cases but no case is registered against the petitioner and therefore, he is not required by the police. They however have categorically stated that they have not caused harassment to the petitioner nor would harass him in future.

Learned State Counsel and learned DDPP have also stated that they would direct the official respondents not to harass petitioner and to behave, act strictly in accordance with law.

The counsel for the petitioner after going through the statements filed by the respondents is satisfied and seeks disposal of the petition. He however submits that copy of order be sent to respondent No.8 for compliance.

It appears that due to involvement of the relatives of the petitioner in certain cases, some of the respondents might have harassed petitioner but since today they have denied the allegations and categorically stated that they would not harass petitioner in future is sufficient for disposal of the instant petition. Consequently, instant

petition is disposed of with directions to official respondents not to harass petitioner or his family only because of the reason that his relatives have been involved in certain cases; as this is no ground to harass the petitioner. The official respondents to behave and act strictly in accordance with law.
