Learned counsel for the applicant first required time, however, when his attention was drawn to the order passed on the earlier date he proceeded with the case. This is a case whereby a suit filed by respondent No.6 claiming to be wife of Late Maqsood Ahmed was decreed by the learned trial Court and the said decree has not been disturbed at the appellate stage whereafter this Civil Revision has been filed.

- 2. Learned counsel for the applicant contended that the marriage ceremony in the matter was said to have occurred in the year 2003 whereas divorce having been followed for 20 years. The respondent No.6 failed to get the CNIC corrected as to the name of husband. He further contends that late Maqsood Ahmed expired on 04.12.2021 whereafter the divorced wife had filed the suit in order to claim benefit not available to her. He further contends that divorce having taken place during life time of deceased in the year 2020 hence the decrees are liable to be disturbed.
- 3. Having gone through the record wherein the learned trial Court having considered the failure of the present appellant to prove his allegation of divorce having been effected on account of

witnesses to the alleged divorce deed which in original never saw the Court. Learned counsel for the applicant is unable to show any ground to disturb the concurrent findings present in the matter. On account of failure of showing any material to disturb the findings the present Civil Revision is found liable to be dismissed in limine and it is so ordered.
