With reference to the order of previous date, learned counsel for the applicant puts his appearance and submits that applicants are not in his contact since long and as such he pleads no instructions.

From the record it appears that this revision is pending since 2003 without any useful progress and the conduct of the applicant reflects that he has lost his interest in this case. In this respect I am fortified by the case of Ghulam Qadir and others v. Sh. Abdul Wadood and others (PLD 2016 SC 712) where the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan, inter-alia has held as under:-

“Revision Court should not be compelled to decide a civil revision on merits in the absence of either party(ies) just because it had been admitted to regular hearing. Court should not be rendered a slave to a person who filed a revision petition and subsequently choose not to appear before the revision Court due to disinterest or ignorance/indolence, and neither should such person be awarded a premium/privilege in such regard, as this would result in (possible) injustice to the contesting party”.

In the circumstances, keeping the matter pending for an indefinite period would not serve any useful purpose, therefore, this civil revision application is dismissed for non prosecution.
