ORDER



MUHAMMAD SALEEM JESSAR, J.-. Through instant bail application, applicant Noor Hassan Jaffer seeks post arrest bail in the case emanating from F.I.R No.56/2023, registered at Police Station B-Section Thull, District Jacobabad for offence punishable under Sections 23(1)(a) and 25 of Sindh Arms Act, 2013. The case has been challaned, which is now pending for trial before the Court of Special Judge, Anti-Terrorism Shikarpur vide Special Case No. 42-A of 2023 (*Re-The State v/s. Noor Hassan Jaffer*). The applicant preferred his bail plea before the Trial Court, which was declined by way of common order dated 03.10.2023; hence this bail application has been maintained.

2. The facts of the case are mentioned in F.I.R, copy whereof has been attached with the memo of bail application, hence need not to be reproduced here again.

3. We have heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned Deputy Prosecutor General and have gone through the material made before us on record.

Since it is an offshoot of the main case bearing Crime No.55 of 2023, registered at Police Station B-Section, Thull for offence punishable under sections 324, 353, 427, 35 P.P.C and 6(H)(i)(M), 7 of the Anti Terrorism Act, 1997; wherein present applicant/accused has been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 21.11.2023, passed in 1st Criminal Bail Application No.D-35 of 2023, therefore, he deserves to be entitled for bail in this case also. Learned Deputy Prosecutor General has no objection. Consequently, instant Criminal Bail Application is hereby allowed. Applicant Noor Hassan Jaffer is admitted to bail subject to his furnishing a solvent surety in the sum of Rs.100,000/- (*Rupees One Hundred Thousands only*) and P.R bond in the like amount to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
