At the very outset learned Addl. P. G has pointed out that the applicant Ali Muhammad had allegedly caused firearm injury to injured PW Muhammad Ramzan, who subsequently died whereas Piyaral had also caused Repeater to deceased Punhal, which hit him on his chest hence specific role of causing firearm injuries to deceased have been assigned to both accused/applicants; besides the offence with which they are charged involves with a capital punishment therefore it would be appropriate for parties to proceed with the trial instead of proceeding with this bail application. When confronted with above situation, Mr.Jatoi, counsel for the applicants as well as learned counsel for the complainant has no objection. Accordingly and in view of above, instant bail application is hereby disposed of. Since the case has been transferred from 2<sup>nd</sup> Additional Sessions Judge, Kamber to 5<sup>th</sup> Additional Sessions Judge, Sukkur, where it is fixed for evidence on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2024, hence the trial Court/5<sup>th</sup> Additional Sessions Judge, Sukkur is hereby directed to expedite the trial and ensure its early conclusion preferably within four months time under intimation to this Court through Additional Registrar. The counsels present undertake to remain present before the trial Court on 5<sup>th</sup> March 2024 along with witnesses. A copy of order shall be communicated to the trial Court through learned Sessions Judge, Sukkur, for compliance through fax.
