Pursuant to order dated 11.06.2026 Chairman Rizwan Ahmed, Incharge Secretary Asif Malik and Controller Examination Nisar Ahmed Memon, Sindh Public Service Commission have effected their appearance and have tendered unconditional apology for their absence on the last date of hearing as well as non-compliance of court's order passed by this Court. They have also submitted a compliance report, from which it transpires that the interview of the petitioner has been conducted; however, the result has not yet been announced. Regarding the announcement of the result, the learned Additional Advocate General, Sindh, submitted that a restraining order has been passed by the learned Circuit Court, Larkana, in Constitutional Petition No. D-460 of 2026, whereby the appointment of Mr. Rizwan Ahmed as Incharge Chairman, Sindh Public Service Commission, was suspended, and the Commission was restrained from announcing any result. For the sake of convenience para-4 of the order is reproduced herein below:-

“Furthermore, any announcement or notification of examination results without the approval of a duly appointed Chairman, or during the period when the office of Chairman remained vacant and was being managed through an unauthorized arrangement, is prima facie, contrary to the mandate of law and suffers from inherent legal infirmity.”

2. From the perusal of the orders passed by the learned Circuit Court Larkana, it transpires that the restraining orders have passed as the Chairman was not duly appointed but an arrangement was made. It has now been apprised that Mr. Rizwan Ahmed has been appointed as the regular Chairman of the Sindh Public Service Commission vide notification dated 12.06.2026, and has also taken oath of his office. Therefore, the impediment to the announcement of the petitioner's result no longer exists.

3. Since the interview of the petitioner has been conducted, as acknowledged by the petitioner himself, the show-cause notices issued to the Chairman, Secretary, and Controller of Examinations of the Sindh Public Service Commission are hereby vacated with note of caution that in future they shall remain careful and shall not deliberately defy the orders of this Court.

4. Petitioner, through the instant petition has prayed for conducting of his interview under the Differently Abled Persons Quota which has been done, therefore the purpose of the petition stands served. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of, along with any pending applications, if any.
