Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J:- Petitioners Mst. Afshan and Muhammad Yaseen have filed this constitutional petition under Article 199 of the Constitution of Pakistan, 1973, seeking protection from alleged harassment by private respondents and unlawful interference by police officials after contracting a freewill marriage following petitioner No.1’s divorce from her previous husband.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that petitioner No.1 had voluntarily married petitioner No.2 and apprehended danger to their lives. Consequently, this Court, vide order dated 18.05.2026, issued notices to the respondents and directed the official respondents to protect the petitioners in accordance with law.

3. In compliance with the Court’s order, the Station House Officer, Moro, filed comments and appeared before the Court, stating that no harassment had been caused to the petitioners and that legal protection would be provided whenever required.

4. Upon being apprised of the official respondents’ stance, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks the disposal of the petition in terms of the comments submitted by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Naushahro Feroze, and the concerned Station House Officers.

5. Having considered the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the statements/comments submitted by the official respondents, it appears that the grievance of the petitioners stands adequately addressed. The official respondents have categorically undertaken that no harassment shall be caused to

the petitioners and that protection shall be extended to them strictly in accordance with law whenever required. Since no further relief survives for adjudication and learned counsel for the petitioners has expressed satisfaction with the assurance furnished by the police authorities, the instant petition is disposed of in terms of the statements and comments of the official respondents.

6. Needless to observe that the official respondents shall remain bound to act strictly in accordance with law and ensure protection of the life and liberty of the petitioners as guaranteed under the Constitution.
