This matter is pending since 2025 without any progress. Diary demonstrates that since inception the applicant has made no efforts to ever have the matter listed or heard. Today, when confronted learned counsel seeks to press question No.1 which pertains to jurisdiction of the respective officers concerned. Learned counsel was asked as to where in the impugned judgment that the questions arise and he refers to paragraph 7.2 and typed page 9 of the impugned judgment.
