ORDER

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J. Petitioner Mst. Saima, widow of late Mansha Rahmat, has invoked the constitutional jurisdiction of this Court under Article 199 of the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, 1973, seeking directions against the respondents for release of all post-retirement and service benefits of her deceased husband. The petitioner has prayed for payment of outstanding dues including gratuity, provident fund, pension, insurance and other admissible benefits, contending that the same are payable under the applicable service rules and regulations and ought to be released without further delay.

2. It has further been prayed that the respondents be directed to pay an amount of Rs. 68,000/- pertaining to the deceased employee, Mansha Rahmat, on account of the alleged arrears since November 2024, in terms of the order of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of Pakistan.

3. On the last date of hearing, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioner. The same position continues even today. It appears that the petitioner has lost interest in pursuing the matter. However, keeping in view that the subject matter relates to pensionary and financial benefits of a deceased employee, this Court deems it appropriate not to non-suit the petitioner on the basis of non-prosecution alone.

4. Accordingly, this petition is disposed of with the observation and direction that the respondents shall, in case the petitioner is found entitled under law and rules, process and decide her claim within a period of one month from the date of receipt of this order, strictly in accordance with law.
