On 06.05.2026, following order was passed:

“Learned counsel states that these matters have been pending since 2010 and respondents are continuously abjuring adjudication. Learned counsel states that the *lis* before the court is no case of first impression as the final judgment of the learned Tribunal has been over-turned by mere recourse to a rectification application. He places reliance on the judgment of the honourable Supreme Court in the case of Chaudhry Steel reported as 2025 SCMR 1505 to demonstrate that the impugned judgment is inconsistent with the law. As a last and final chance to facilitate the respondents these matters are adjourned to 13.05.2026. Office is instructed to place copy of this order in connected matters”

The respondents remain unrepresented, however, per learned counsel for the applicant there is no case to perpetuate these matters in the docket since 16 years have already been passed.

Learned counsel for the applicant states that the question to be decided herein is whether the final judgment of the learned Tribunal could be over-turned as undertaken herein vide the same recourse to a rectification application. Learned counsel states that the said question has already been answered in favour of the applicant department vide the judgment cited supra and the said judgment is binding upon this court. In view hereof and in mutatis mutandis application of the judgment cited, the question framed is answered in favour of the applicant department. These references are disposed of.
