- 2,4&5. As the FIR has been lodged at Police Station Manghopir within the jurisdiction of District West Karachi, the petitioners have approached this Court through the instant petition. Petitioner No.1 has annexed certain documents with the petition reflecting that she has contracted marriage with Petitioner No.2 of her own free will and consent. However, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that to approach the concerned Court for appropriate relief regarding the validity of the FIR, as well as to enable Petitioner No.1 to record her statement before the Investigating Officer in the said crime, the petitioners would be satisfied if directions are issued to Respondents No.2 and 3 to protect them as and when they approach the concerned authorities or Court.

Since it is an inalienable right of the petitioners to seek protection at the hands of the police functionaries while pursuing their legal remedies, Respondents No.2 to 6 are hereby directed to protect the petitioners as and when they approach the concerned forum, as well as for the purpose of recording the statement of Petitioner No.1 before the Investigating Officer. The Investigating Officer is further directed to proceed strictly in accordance with law and to refrain from taking any coercive action or effecting arrest

unless sufficient and tangible material surfaces during the course of investigation.

It is pertinent to note that the FIR has been registered under Section 365-B PPC regarding the alleged abduction of Petitioner No.1; however, through this petition she has not supported the allegations contained in the FIR and has expressed her intention to approach the competent forum for appropriate relief.

In view of the above, this petition is disposed of with the direction to the police functionaries to ensure compliance and provide protection to the petitioners as and when required.
