MUHAMMAD IQBAL KALHORO J: A police team of P.S. NKIA, Karachi arrested applicant on 04.03.2026 from main road Saba Chowrangi Sector New Karachi on suspicion and allegedly recovered 1500 grams Charas, hence he was booked in FIR bearing Cr. No.119/2026 U/s 9(1) 3(c), Sindh, CNS Act, 2025 of P.S. NKIA, Karachi.

2. Applicant's counsel has submitted that applicant has been falsely implicated in this case due to enmity with police constables against which a sister in law of applicant had already filed an application u/s 22-A & B Cr.P.C; applicant is a butcher by profession and dealing in beef business; applicant was arrested from his house and nothing was recovered from him.

3. On the other hand, learned Addl.P.G. has opposed bail to applicant stating that arrest and recovery have been recorded on video and more so applicant has past criminal history and almost six cases of similar nature have been registered against him.

4. We have considered pleas of the respective parties and are of a view that *prima facie* there are reasonable grounds to believe that applicant is involved in this case. The recovery and arrest are recorded on video. The same are also supported by witnesses in their statements u/s 161 Cr.P.C. In some of the past cases applicant is stated to be on bail, yet *prima facie* he has repeated the present offence which amounts to misuse of concession of bail. No case for concession of bail therefore, is made out. Application by purported sister in law of the applicant against two police constables much prior to FIR *prima facie* has no nexus with the present case and is not helpful to the applicant. Accordingly, this

bail application is dismissed. However, we are hopeful that learned trial court will expedite the trial and examine material witnesses in three months.

The Cr. Bail Application is disposed of.

The observations made hereinabove are tentative in nature and would not prejudice case of either party at trial.
