While numerous questions have been proposed and it is also pointed out that while admitting the factum of smuggling the seized goods been released on redemption fine etc. contrary to the law, learned counsel states that the impugned judgment has been rendered by a Single Member of the learned Tribunal is excessive pecuniary jurisdiction.

Learned counsel states that pursuant to order for substituted service, service has been effected through publication and the relevant newspaper excerpt is available on file.

Learned counsel seeks that it may be in the interest of justice and revenue, the impugned judgment be set-aside and matter be remanded back for adjudication afresh by the learned Division Bench of the Tribunal in accordance with law. Order accordingly.
