1. Though none is present on behalf of the petitioner however matter pertains to SBICA hence by way of indulgence urgency is granted.

3. Exemption granted subject to all just exception.

2,4&5. Ms. Humaira Jatoi, learned counsel for Sindh Building Control Authority (SBICA), who is present in Court in connection with other cases, waives notice on behalf of SBICA. She informs the Court that the Authority has introduced a Smart Complaint Redressal Mechanism (SCRM), along with an Appellate Committee, for redressal of grievances of the nature raised by the petitioner. She adds that the petitioner may approach the competent authority by filing an appropriate application/complaint through SCRM portal, which shall be entertained and decided in accordance with law and applicable SOPs.

In view of above, and without entering into or expressing any opinion on merits of the controversy, the petitioner may approach the competent authority by filing an appropriate application/complaint through SCRM in accordance with the prescribed procedure and applicable SOPs. In the event such application/complaint is filed, the Director General, SBICA, shall ensure that the same is placed before the competent authority for consideration and decision. The competent authority shall, after affording a fair opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as all other concerned/affected parties, decide the application/complaint, preferably within a period of sixty (60) days from the date of its filing, strictly in accordance with law and the applicable

Rules/SOPs, through a reasoned order. The decision so taken shall be communicated to all concerned without unnecessary delay.

Since an alternate departmental mechanism for redressal of the petitioner's grievance is available, no further adjudication is called for by this Court at this stage. Accordingly, instant petition stands **disposed of**, alongwith all pending application(s), without expressing any opinion on merits of the petitioner's claim.

Needless to observe that, if any party remains aggrieved by decision of the competent authority, it shall be at liberty to avail such remedy as may be available under the law.

Office shall transmit a copy of this order to the Director General, Sindh Building Control Authority, through available expeditious mode for information and compliance. Learned MIT-II shall ensure compliance.
