ORDER

Adnan-ul-Karim Memon, J. Petitioner filed this Constitutional Petition under Article 199 of the Constitution of Islamic Republic of Pakistan 1973, seeking following relief(s):-

i. To declare the acts, deeds and omissions of the Respondent No.5 & 6 regarding blocking the Bank Account of the Petitioner, are illegal and unlawful.

ii. To direct the respondent No.5 & 6 to immediately Unblock and Restore the Bank Account of the Petitioner enabling Petitioner to make the his Transactions smoothly without any kind of restrictions from the respondents.

iii. To direct the respondent No.1 to 4 to Unblock the CNIC of the Petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for NADRA submitted that, as per the V&R Branch report, the petitioner's CNIC No. 42201-9969647-1 has been cleared vide letter dated 18.08.2026, therefore, the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed.

3. When confronted with the legal position of the case, counsel for the petitioner is satisfied and seeks disposal of the petition in terms of the statement so made by counsel for the NADRA.

4. Accordingly, without touching the merits of the case and with the consent of the parties, this petition, along with pending applications, if any, is disposed of.
