2to5. Through the instant petition, the petitioners have challenged the show-cause notice issued to them in respect of the alleged non-compliance with the directions issued by the Tribunal vide order dated 06.08.2026. The impugned show-cause notice is available at page-27 of the Court file; whereas the Tribunal’s order dated 06.08.2026 is available at page-25.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that contempt proceedings have been initiated against the petitioners and that they apprehend adverse action pursuant thereto.

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and have perused the impugned show-cause notice. A plain reading thereof demonstrates that, at this stage, the petitioners have merely been called upon to show cause regarding the alleged non-compliance of the Tribunal’s directions. No final or adverse order has yet been passed against the petitioners. The petitioners, therefore, have an adequate and efficacious opportunity to submit their response before the competent forum and to place on record all facts and grounds in their defence. In the absence of any final adverse order or determination against the petitioners, the apprehension of possible adverse action, by itself, does not furnish a sufficient basis for interference by this Court

at this stage. The petition, being premature, is therefore not maintainable.

In view of above, instant petition is **dismissed** in *limini* along with listed applications.
