By consent of both the learned counsel for the parties, Mr. Dilawar Hussain, advocate, is appointed as Commissioner for recording evidence in the matter. It is expected that the parties must have filed list of witnesses at the relevant time. In case any of the parties has inadvertently failed to file list of witnesses within one week they may file list of witnesses, place it in on Court record, obtain certified copy and provide copy of that list of documents to the learned Commissioner for recording of evidence. Any document or attempt to be produced without having any acknowledgement of deposit of list of documents in the Court shall not be allowed to be taken on record by the learned Commissioner for recording of evidence. The learned Commissioner is also directed to continue recording of evidence even if any objection is being raised or uncalled for document is being produced before him, he may take them on record with observations. All such disputes regarding the objections and production of documents will subsequently be decided by the Court before final hearing subject to completion of evidence within four months from today. The plaintiffs have already filed their affidavit-in-evidence, a copy of that affidavit-in-evidence may be supplied to the learned Commissioner alongwith copy of pleadings by both the parties. The parties are directed to file their respective affidavits-in-evidences before the learned Commissioner. The fees of the learned Commissioner is fixed at Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) per witness, to be borne by the respective parties for their witnesses.
