1. Granted.

2 to 4 Learned counsel states that FIR of abduction of the detenu has been registered bearing FIR No.181/2014 P.S. Badin u/s 365-B, 494, 496 PPC. The said FIR is under investigation and if the applicant is aggrieved by the conduct of the Investigating Officer, he has to approach proper forum or make an application before the competent court of law having jurisdiction of P.S where FIR was lodged for seeking directions to the Investigating Officer for conducting proper investigation or transfer of investigation to some other police officer. The other aspect of the case is that the abductee has been living with her father when she was allegedly kidnapped by the respondent No.2, therefore, FIR has been lodged by father of the detenu. The petitioner should help his father in law in investigation of the case through police instead of opening a new issue through this petition.

In the above circumstances, instant petition is not maintainable in law and is dismissed. However, it is expected that the concerned police shall ensure the recovery of the alleged abductee and produce her before the court having jurisdiction in terms of FIR.
