Mr. Waqar Ali Memon Advocate files vakalatnama on behalf of respondents No.3 to 6, which is taken on record.

Through this petition, the petitioner has sought legal protection and directions to the respondent No.1 for registration of FIR against respondents No.2 to 6. The petitioner in para 3 of his petition has stated that respondent No.6, who is his brother had borrowed Rs.300,000/- from him with promise to return the same but did not return rather extending threats to withdraw from the amount. Admittedly there is dispute regarding recovery of amount allegedly paid by the petitioner to his brother respondent No.6 as loan, which is purely a civil nature dispute, which cannot be entertained in the constitutional petition. Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to answer as to how the petitioner instead of approaching the Civil court has filed instant petition, which is not maintainable in law.

In view of the above circumstances, petition is dismissed as not maintainable.
