There are two different statements of accounts, one filed by the Plaintiff that is known as Overdue Acceptance Account and the other is current account filed by the Defendant with their leave to defend application. The claim of the Defendant is that the current account which was being utilized by him towards facility does not show any outstanding balance. However, suit has been filed on the basis of Overdue Acceptance Account. Learned counsel for the Plaintiff is directed to satisfy the Court that whether the transactions reflected in their Overdue Acceptance Account were disclosed to the customer before coming to Court or not and whether it's non-disclosure is covered by statutory rules, he should disclose such rule and such non-disclosure is justifiable or not. Matter is only partly heard and beside the above the Plaintiff will entitle to argue on the other grounds raised in the application for leave to defend.
