Learned counsel for the petitioner is satisfied with the observation that police officials who are respondents in the civil suit and having no relationship with each other is already having civil suit before the trial Court. Stay order has also been granted by the civil Court however, the petitioner is refrained that he is misusing the powers of police officials. Except oral allegation that he is misusing the authority as police official, there is nothing on record. In any case, factual controversy cannot be decided in constitution petition, however, police officials is restrained from taking law in their hands.

With the above observation, this petition is disposed of. However, the parties are directed to maintain the stay order in terms of the trial Court and no person should be violated the order of the trial Court and parties are directed to approach the trial Court in accordance with law.
