3. Granted, subject to all just exceptions.

2&4. Learned counsel for the petitioner says that son in law of his client was partner of the Respondents No. 3 to 6 and he has died. Now the Petitioner being father-in-law of the deceased under the authority of his daughter wants to interfere with the partnership business of the deceased and claims that the private respondents are not giving him excess of account of the business.

On the face of it, the petitioner has no right to interfere with the partnership business of the private Respondents. Even otherwise, this is civil dispute between the parties which can be resolved by a civil suit for accounts of partnership of the deceased through a family of the deceased. No case for harassment is made out, therefore, this petition is dismissed.
