In continuation of the order dated 14.1.2015 and 23.1.2015 M/s.Pakistan Council of Architects and Town Planners (PCATP) having office No.4, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, 61-C, 21<sup>st</sup> Commercial Street, Phase-II Extension, DHA Karachi, is directed to nominate / appoint any qualified registered Architect and Town Planner to examine the technical proposal submitted by the Plaintiff to Defendants No.1 to 4 and the technical proposal advanced / submitted by Defendants No.5 to 11 and also visit the site and submit report to the effect that whether technical proposal advanced by the Plaintiff is being utilized by the Defendants No.1 to 4 through the Defendants No.5 to 11 and also to specify whether the difference, if any, is worth claiming that the two proposals are from different minds or there is just formal difference and the proposal designed by the Plaintiff, is being used by the Defendants in developing a modern and state of the art residential scheme of DHA City. Relevant documents have already been handed over by the Defendants No.1 to 4 to the Nazir of this Court. However, the experts once nominated by the PCATP shall be free to claim any document from either party to examine and come to a final conclusion / report in compliance of the

above orders. The cost / fee expenses for providing the services of the expert to carry out the assignment may be suggested by the PCATP in consultation with the Plaintiff. It is expected that PCATP will complete the task within 30 days from the date of taking over documents and starting the activity. Whatever documents filed with the Nazir once handed over to the PCATP, the parties to this suit will be allowed to have an access to those documents.
