ORDER

SAJJAD ALI SHAH, J: We have heard the learned counsel for adicial Assistant preme coun of Paking parties. All present agree that since the relationship between the parties as landlady and tenants is not disputed, therefore, the findings of the High Court upsetting the concurrent findings of two courts below for want of relationship cannot be sustained and consequently, the order impugned in these petitions be set aside and the matter be remanded back to the High Court for decision afresh on merits on all the remaining issues. Order accordingly. Since these are old matters,

we expect that the learned High Court would endeavor to decide the same within a period of three months. The petitions are converted into appeals, allowed and remanded.
